Our board is comprised of five individuals with deep roots in theatre and performance, both in the greater Victoria region and internationally. Our artistic director, Sasha Moriarty-Schieven, is a seasoned theatre professional with 34 years of experience in the performing arts. She holds a Bachelor's degree in Musical Theatre with a minor in Early Childhood Education.

5. What is your organization's history of providing benefit to the residents of Esquimalt?

Since securing space, we have created community events such as once-a-month family karaoke, sing-along movie days, and craft creation afternoons all free. We also offer Pro-D Day camps and winter, spring, and summer break musical theatre camps and theatre classes. We also offer the opportunity for families to participate in theatrical productions, such as A Christmas Carol in December 2024.

Theatre al Dente enriches the community by offering specialized musical theatre eduction and performances tailored to families and young performers. We also offer family enrichment activities such as karaoke, musical sing alongs, crafts and D&D.

The camps, classes, performances, donations and rental of the space all help to support TaD financially. We have been self-sufficient for the last several years but want to expand our community offerings to additional shows and programing in 2025.

We would like to produce and perform a community theatre production of full musical production of Anne of Green Gables in June 2025. The audition process would be open to all residence and we especially encourage families to participate together. The rehearsals would take place in our clubhouse and the performances at Esquimalt High. The key goal is to provide an affordable evening of entertainment to residence of Esquimalt. The production process for a full musical is 5 months long with preproduction starting in January, auditions in March, rehearsals until performances in June. We would like to include as many community members as possible in all aspects of the production process, from marketing, technical, prop and set building, makeup, costumes, and actors.

9. How will your organization measure whether the program or event was a success?

Program success is measured in community involvement in both the production process and in the number of tickets sold - generally 75 to 80% theatre capacity is considered very successful.

In the event we do not receive funding we will reduce the production scope and size along with additional fund raiser activities.
