




Adjusted claims cost

Year-to-date cost relief




- The OHS Manager submitted successful cost relief applications to WorkSafe BC
- As a result, \$194,098.13 in claim costs were eliminated from the Township's Claims Costs
- This reduction directly impacts the calculation of future WorkSafe premium payments

The successful appeal securing relief of costs on a past WorkSafeBC claim highlights the importance of diligent case management and audit processes. Combined with building inspections and targeted risk assessments, these initiatives have created a stronger safety culture within the Township.
