





Open and active year on year November

 The number of active businesses increased by 4.9% between November 2023 and November 2024

Renewed year on year April

 Existing business licences showed a modest growth of 2.3% (from 699 to 715)

Uncertainty in the geo-political environment

- The number of businesses closed increased by 14.5%
- 32 to 55 (an increase of 71%) in the outstanding business licences (so neither active nor closed) indicates the uncertainty and lack of business confidence due to the ongoing geo-political environment.
