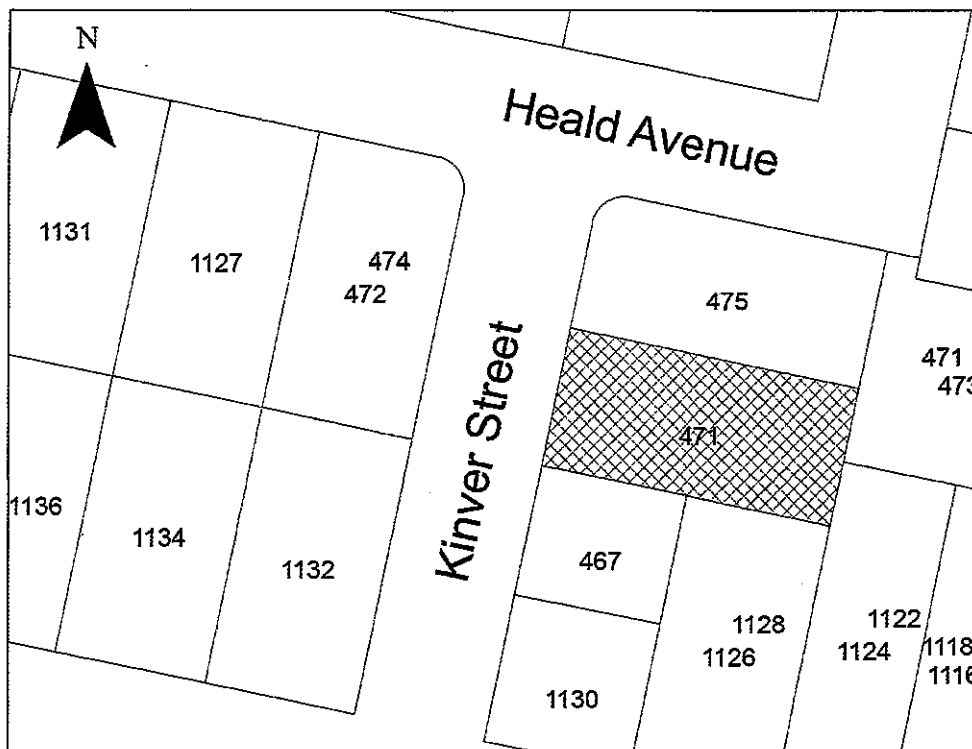
# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
