DEV-17-041

Director of Development Services provided an overview, supplemented by a Powerpoint presentation, of the advantages and disadvantages of removing medians in commercial nodes of the downtown precinct and Head Street precinct along Esquimalt Road. The Director of Development Services responded to questions from Council.

Council comments included:

- * Tree / plant height blocks sightlines - change to smaller trees / lower plantings
- * Request for background information from decision making process for installation of medians
- * Medians provide safety elements - traffic calming / speed reduction / pedestrian safety
- * Bury utilities to increase room on sidewalks
- * Consider obtaining frontage instead of removing medians when redevelopment takes place
- * Engage stakeholders for input / roundtables to determine competing demands
- * Median removal / aesthetics will lack uniformity (piece-meal effect) if done as redevelopment takes place
- * Medians provide ambiance
- * Consider alternates to removing medians to obtain additional space
- * Cannot decrease on-street parking / need to increase on-street / commercial parking
