I understand the need for waste trucks and emergency vehicles to have unimpeded access to the cul-de-sac. I am concerned however, that more cars will be pushed in front of my property (1115). Cars already often block my driveway and dangerous glare from side mirrors is blinding in the front room. With the major townhouse project going in on Lampson just around the corner from Norma Court-coupled with an imminent reduction in parking on Lampson, Norma Court really needs Residential Parking Only enforcement as well.
1116 Norma Crt	Jenny Holder & Jackson Whiting	Email	16-05-2016	In favour of Option 1		Our strong preference would be that the proposed parking restriction in front of 1117 Norma Court is an All Time Parking restriction. Our drive way, which is the only driveway we have(no rear access like others) is directly across from part of the critical area on the cul-de-sac that Township is concerned with. We share the same concerns about access due to vehicles being parked on the road directly across from our driveway. Since we moved into our home in Oct 2015 there have been more than ten times that we were blocked in our driveway due to someone parking on the street across from our driveway. Jackson runs a small gardening business (registered with Esquimalt) from our home and he needs to be able to maneuver his trailer and his truck in and out of the driveway in order to conduct his business. There have been times when he was held up for up to 2 hours while waiting for vehicle to be moved before he could leave for work or return home and park in our driveway. We are also concerned about emergency vehicle access on the road. If there were a fire or other emergency the access could be an issue depending on the size of the vehicle parked on the part of the road of concern here. We are asking that our feedback be taken seriously as it directly impacts our daily life in our normal home and small business activities.

I believe this is a real concern for safety at all times and should an emergency vehicle need to get down during weekends or evenings it could be a disaster if cars are parked on both sides of the street.
1120 Norma Crt	Mr. and Mrs. Gardner	In person	16-05-2016	In favour of Option 1		We live at 1120 Norma Court and our neighbours right next to us are at 116 Norma Court. We have been here for 28 years and have had a serious increase in problems in getting in and out of our driveways due to vehicles parking so often on the 1117 boulevard turn. When people park directly behind our driveways on that turn we cannot get out of our driveway. This problem is not a 7am to 5pm problem, it will happen to us at all different times a day, 7 days a week. The other issue that makes the All Time Parking Restriction the best solution on the 1117 Norma Court boulevard side is that the Municipal waste collection vehicles are having trouble getting through there when a vehicle parks on that boulevard, but it also hinders any larger commercial vehicle and especially an emergency vehicle that may need to get through there at any given hour of the day.
