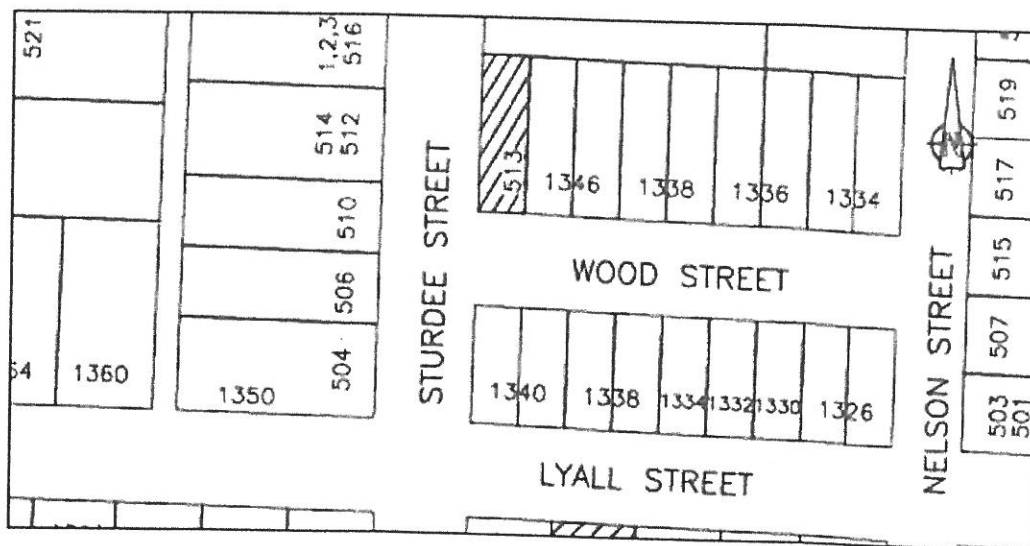
DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT NOTICE

An application for a Development Variance Permit has been received from Angus Denny, the registered owner of 513 Sturdee Street, PID 006-375-201, Lot 53, Suburban Lot 53, Esquimalt District, Plan 2854.

Purpose of the Application:

The owner is building a two-unit dwelling on the subject property [up-down duplex], and is requesting that the overhead wiring connection, that was used for the former small house on the property, continue to be used for the new building. A hydro pole exists at the north-west corner of the property.

Therefore, the owner requests a variance to **"Subdivision and Development Control Bylaw, 1997, No. 2175" - Section 14.01 Underground wiring and Schedule E - 5.01(c)**; which requires that the connections for electrical power, telephone and television communications be installed underground.
