Proposed Addition to Reserve - Esquimalt Indian Band Proposed Addition of Land to Esquimalt Indian Reserve

This letter is to inform you that the Esquimalt Indian Band has formally requested certain land to be set apart as an addition to Esquimalt Indian Reserve.

The proposed addition to reserve comprise of approximately 1.231 hectares (3.0418672 Acres) of land are Northwest of the Township of Esquimalt and these parcels are contiguous to Esquimalt Indian Reserve.

Lot 42 (approximately 0.162 hectares or 0.4003 acres) Lot 43 (approximately 0.076 hectares or 0.1878 acres) Lot 44 (approximately 0.524 hectares or 1.2948 acres) Lot 45 (approximately 0.409 hectares or 1.0106 acres) Lot 46 (approximately 0.022 hectares or 0.0543 acres) Lot 47 (approximately 0.038 hectares or 0.0939 acres)

The legal description of the land is:

In the province of British Columbia In Esquimalt District Adjacent to Esquimalt Indian Reserve

All of Lots 42, 43, 44, 45, 46 and 47 as shown on plan 81095 recorded in the Canada Lands Surveys Records in Ottawa. A copy of the said plan is filed in the Land Title Office in Victoria under number VIP67051.

Containing an area of about 1.231 hectares.

Please note Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) had previously consulted with the Township of Esquimalt in 2006 regarding this proposed addition to reserve. In response, the Chief Administrative Officer advised they had no



concerns (see attached letter). AANDC would like to confirm that the Township of Esquimalt has no concerns with this proposed addition to reserve.

Please provide us with any comments or concerns that the Township of Esquimalt may have by **November 18, 2015**.




