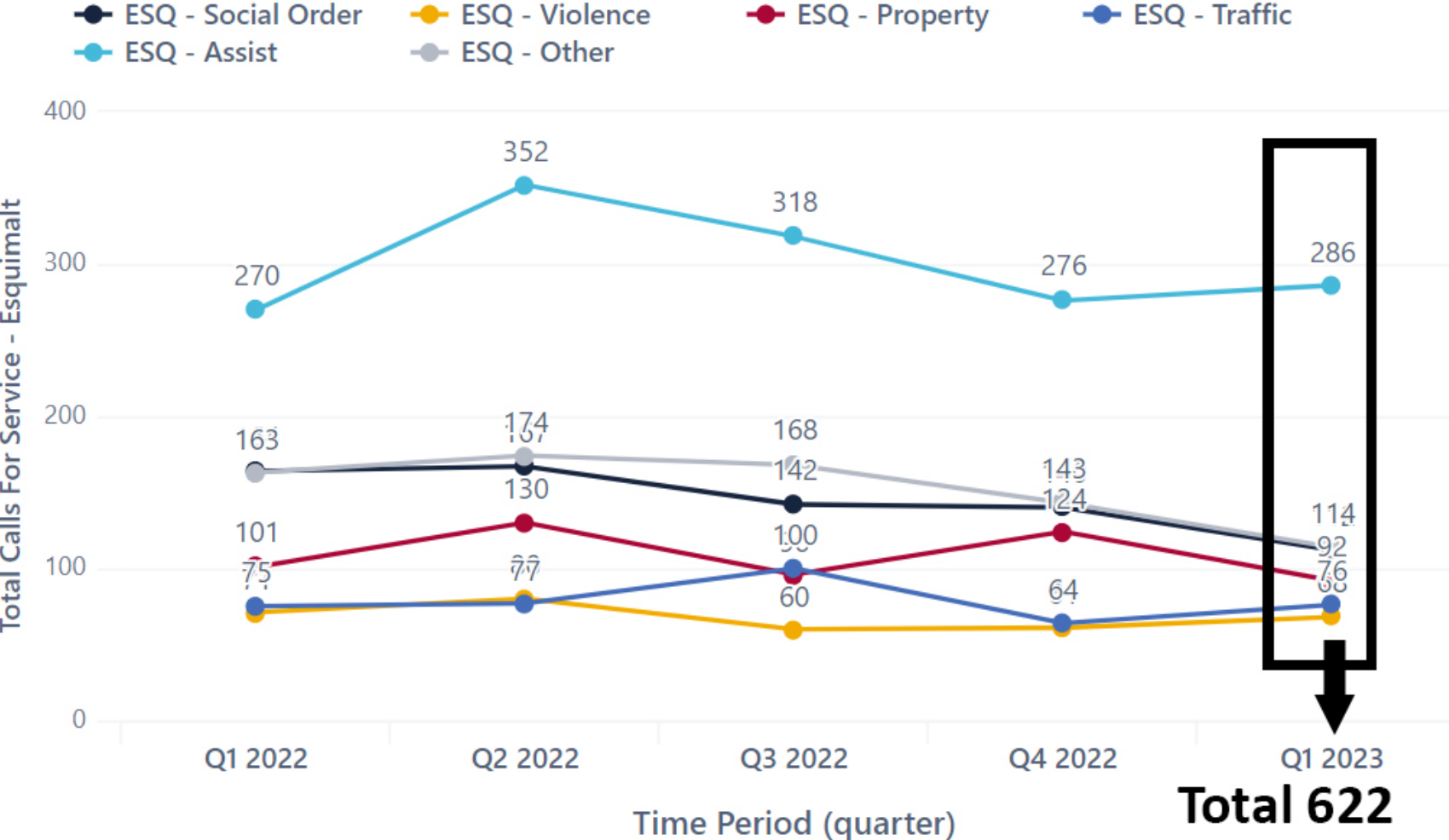

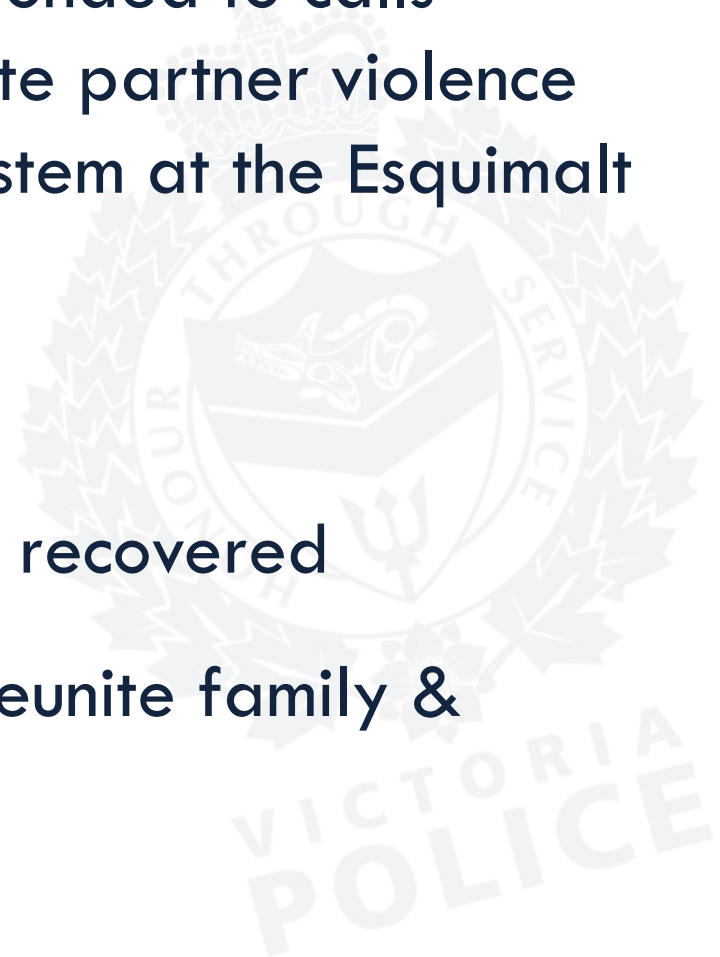
Crime Prevention & Public Safety
