Community Safety Services

1) <u>22-301</u> Public Safety Building - Financial Update - Staff Report No. CSS-22-006

The Director of Community Safety Services introduced the report and together with Alec Page from Core Project Management and the Director of Financial Services, responded to guestions from Council.

- Concerns whether will be the final request for increased funding.
- Updates should be forwarded to Council as changes in costs occur.

2) 22-346 Canada Community Building Fund BC – Strategic Priorities Fund: Capital Infrastructure Stream - Staff Report, Staff Report No. CSS-22-008
