

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BYLAW NO. 3010

A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No. 2432, cited as the
“Business Regulation (Second Hand Dealers and Pawnbrokers), 2000, No. 2432”

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the “Business Regulation (Second Hand Dealers and Pawnbrokers), 2000, No. 2432, Amendment Bylaw [No. 1], 2020, No. 3010”
2. That Bylaw No. 2432, cited as the “Business Regulation (Second Hand Dealers and Pawnbrokers), 2000, No. 2432” be amended as follows:
 - (1) That Section 4 be deleted and replaced with the following:

The Register shall be in the English language and shall be written legibly, typewritten or recorded in electronic fashion.
 - (2) That Section 9 be amended as follows:

The word “Police” replaces the words “Chief Constable”.
 - (3) That Section 10 be deleted and replaced with the following:

Every Dealer shall have delivered to the Police on each Friday, before the hour of 10:00 a.m. a complete copy, which may be a carbon copy, photocopy, or an electronic version, of all entries made in the Register during the preceding seven days.
 - (4) That Section 11 be amended as follows:

The word “Police” replaces the words “Chief Constable” in each instance they appear within the Section.
 - (5) That Section 18 be amended as follows:

The word “Police” replaces words “Chief Constable” in each instance they appear within the Section.
 - (6) That Section 19 be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - (1) Every Person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw commits an offence which is punishable in accordance with the *Community Charter*.
 - (2) Every person who is guilty of an offence under this Bylaw is liable to a fine of not more than \$10,000 or to imprisonment for not more than six months or to both.

- (3) A separate offence shall be deemed to be committed upon each day during and in which the contravention occurs or continues.
- (4) This Bylaw may be enforced by the issuing of a ticket for contravention in accordance with the *Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw, 2005, No. 2619* or the *Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw, 2014, No. 2839*, as may be amended or replaced from time to time.
- (5) The penalties imposed under this Section shall be in addition to and not in substitution for any other penalty or remedy that may be imposed pursuant to this Bylaw or otherwise by law.

READ a second time on the 21st day of December, 2020.

READ a third time on the 21st day of December, 2020.
