- * Increased options to extract energy resources from waste with advancements in technology.
- * Determining appropriate locations for disposal of end product solids that are financially and environmentally viable.
- * Concerns of Hartland landfill's capacity and moving forward with options to reduce waste.

The Director of Engineering and Public Works advised he is attending a meeting with the CRD on September 26th regarding waste programs.

Moved by Councillor Brame, seconded by Councillor Armour: That the COTW receive Staff Report No. EPW-19-032 for information and direct staff to prepare a report with "Option 1: to proceed with the project in 2019" for Council's consideration. Carried Unanimously.
