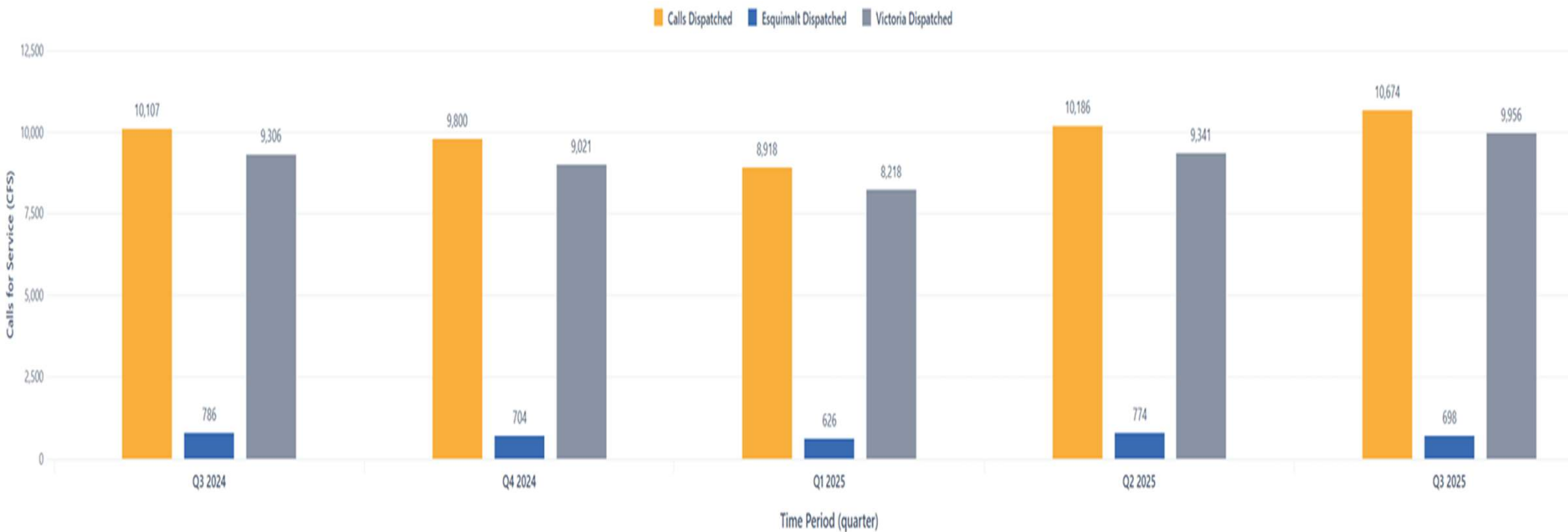

Notable Files

July 30 – Fatal Collision (25-29039)

- Serious MVI at Esquimalt & Head; one fatality
- Intersection closed overnight; collision analysts investigating

August 24 – Suspicious Explosive Item (25-32887)

- Report of claymore-style device near Esquimalt & Macaulay
- Patrol, ERT, and EDU responded; evacuations completed
- EDU confirmed item was inert via drone and X-ray

September 10 – Mental Health Barricade (25-35530)

- Person in crisis barricaded with a weapon on Head Street
- ERT, K-9, and patrol deployed; subject apprehended under Sec. 28 MHA

Rib Fest Counterfeit Tokens (25-35469)

- Fake beer tokens used; approx. \$2,000 loss
- Investigation ongoing; prevention measures identified

August 29 – Pellet Gun Assault (25-33604)

- Shots fired at vehicles on Esquimalt Road
- Suspect vehicle later seen by Westshore RCMP but fled
- GIS investigating; linked to similar regional, possibly gang-related events
