

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BYLAW NO. 3140

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2665, cited as the
“Parks and Recreation Regulation Bylaw, 2007, No. 2665”

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the “Parks and Recreation Regulation Bylaw, 2007, No. 2665, Amendment Bylaw, 2024, No. 3140.”
2. That Bylaw No. 2665, cited as the “Parks and Recreation Bylaw, 2007, No. 2665” be amended as follows:
 - (1) By deleting from Schedule C - Fees and Rental Charges section 4.8 the words “September 15 to March 15,” and “between 10 am and 10 pm”.
 - (2) By deleting from Schedule C - Fees and Rental Charges section 5.2 under the column “Age by Definition” and along the row “Youth”, the words “Will be added as a category in Class for recording purposes” and replace with the following “Will be added as a category for recording purposes”.
 - (3) By deleting from Schedule C - Fees and Rental Charges section 6 the words “(up to a maximum of 52 visits per year)”.
 - (4) By deleting from Schedule C - Fees and Rental Charges section 6 the word “discounts” and replacing it with the word “credits”.
 - (5) By inserting Fees and Charges Table attached as Appendix I to this bylaw as new section 8 of Schedule C.
3. **This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2025.**
