An application for a change in zoning has been received from the registered owner of 460 Head Street and 464 Head Street.


Purpose of the Bylaw:

Zoning Bylaw, 1992, No. 2050, Amendment Bylaw No. 2896 provides for changes to zoning designations as follows:

- 1) change the zoning designation of 460 Head Street [legal description below] shown hatched on the map below, from West Bay Commercial [C-7] to Comprehensive Development District No. 103 [CD No. 103].
- 2) change the zoning designation of 464 Head Street [legal description below] shown hatched on the map below, from Single Family Residential [RS-1] to Comprehensive Development District No. 103 [CD No. 103].

This bylaw would facilitate redevelopment of the site as a new 5 storey, commercial/ residential mixed use building containing ground floor commercial space oriented toward Head Street and a maximum of 12 residential units.
