# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

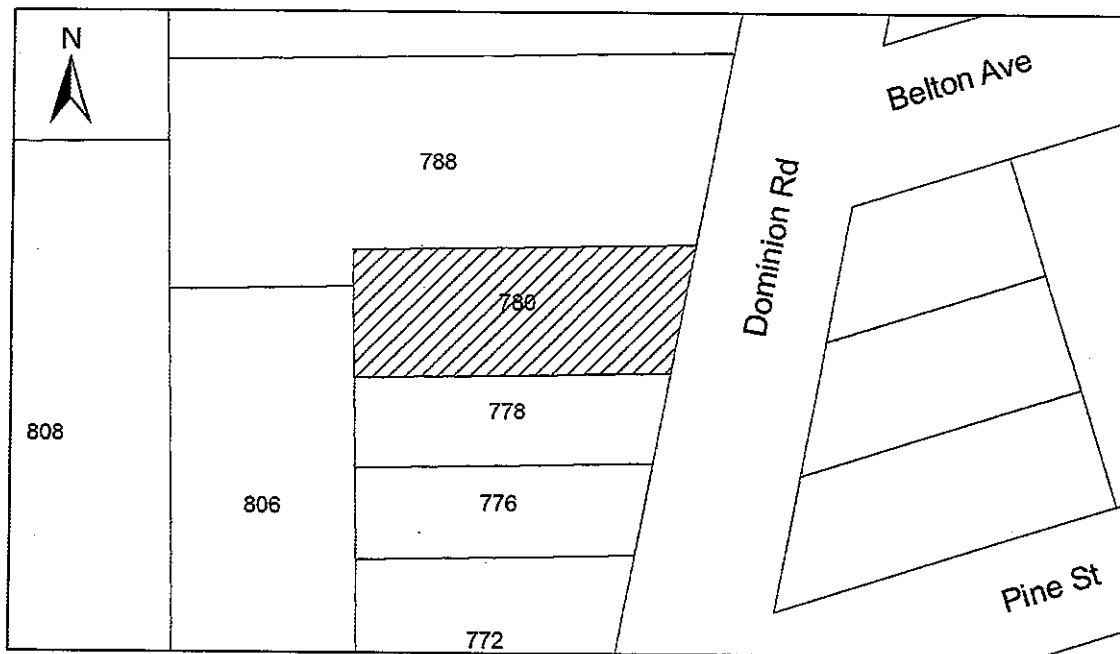
An application for a change in zoning has been received from the registered owner of 780 Dominion Road.

### Purpose of the Bylaw:

Zoning Bylaw, 1992, No. 2050, Amendment Bylaw No. 2905 provides for a change in the zoning designation of 780 Dominion Road [legal description below] shown hatched on the map below from Multiple Family Residential [RM-3] to CD No. 104 [Comprehensive Development District No. 104].

This bylaw would add the use, 'Group Children's Day Care Centre' to the site; to allow a daycare of up to 75 square metres, located on the first and second storey of a building. Subject to the Provincial *Community Care and Assisted Living Act*, this should allow for the care of up to 16 children on the site at any one time.


