1) <u>18-211</u> Mayor and Council Compensation Review, Staff Report ADM-18-014

Staff and Ms. Case responded to questions from Council.

Moved by Councillor Morrison, seconded by Councillor Low: That remuneration for the future Mayor and Council, commencing terms of office on November 1, 2018, shall be the independently identified median rate of \$57,600 for the position of Mayor and the remuneration for Councillors shall be set at 40% of that of the Mayor's remuneration, as per Council Remuneration Bylaw No. 2836, and consistent with "the Median (P50) Councillor salary as a percent of Mayor salary of 40%" identified by the independent consultant's study of ten comparable municipalities representing all regions of the province. Carried Unanimously.

2) <u>18-216</u> Amendments to Council Policies re Council Remuneration, Staff Report ADM-18-016

Moved by Councillor Low, seconded by Councillor Brame: That Council defer consideration of any proposed revisions to Council Policy ADMIN-58 Review & Market Analysis of Council Remuneration and Council Policy ADMIN-62 Remuneration for Elected Officials until further information has been provided by staff, including tax implications and options.
