Subject: Reconsideration of Motion re Rezoning application for 1109 Lyall Street, from August 20, 2018 Council meeting

Council Agenda: August 27, 2018

Recommendation:

I request that Council reconsider and vote again on the following motion, which was defeated at the August 20, 2018 meeting of Council:

"That Council consider an application to amend the Zoning Bylaw in order to allow for the development of a new two-unit dwelling behind the existing single family home at 1109 Lyall Street [PID 006-001-009, Amended Lot 3 (DD 148436), Section 11, Esquimalt District, Plan 4729] and upon such consideration, instruct staff how Council wishes to proceed with the application – namely to prepare the amending Bylaws."

Background:

At the August 20th Council meeting, the above motion was defeated by Council. On August 22, 2018, I received a telephone call from the applicant, Ms. Kim. Colpman. She requested support in approaching Council for reconsideration of the motion to allow a Rezoning Application for 1109 Lyall Street to proceed.

Process and Requirements:

Pursuant to Section 28 (1)(a) of Council Procedure Bylaw No. 2715, 2009, and subject to subsection (5), a Council member who voted on the prevailing side may, at the next Council meeting move to reconsider a matter on which a vote, other than to postpone indefinitely, has been taken.
