FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the Tourism Passport?

The VGSN issues a Tourism Passport to all front-line hospitality members that attend the Showcase. Tourism Passport holders receive complimentary admission for themselves and a friend to participating attractions in Greater Victoria, as well as discounts for out of town offers.

What are the benefits of participating?

When individuals experience a product or service first-hand, they can heedfully relate to it. Knowledge of their experience is then shared with others and recommended with confidence. Consequently, the Tourism Passport simulates booking referrals and word-of-mouth exposure, while at the same time, strengthens the relationship between tourism employees and business owners/operators.

The Tourism Passport is the primary incentive for front-line hospitality members to attend the Tourism Showcase.

How much does participation cost?

Participation in the Tourism Passport is complimentary and exclusive to exhibitors of the Tourism Showcase.

Can I set restrictions on my offer?
