Veterans Banner – Order Form

Who is Eligible to be Honoured on a Banner:

- Any man or woman, living or deceased, who served, or continues to serve, Canada or its allies, in a war, on a peacekeeping mission, or in the Cold War
- They should have served in the military, the merchant marine, or in the nursing or other medical corps during the conflict
- The person should have some connection to the Parry Sound District (born here, grew up here, lived here, or related to a current resident)
- There must be a picture of the person available of sufficient resolution to put on a banner

Where & When Will Banners be Displayed:

- the banners will displayed every year in downtown Parry Sound and along Bowes Street from Thanksgiving weekend to Nov. 15

Cost of Sponsorship:

- Individuals, families, or organizations can sponsor one side of a banner to honour one veteran for a cost of \$100 (Banners are provided at cost; THIS IS NOT A FUNDRAISER)
- Banner will be displayed for as many years as it remains in good repair; when normal wear and tear prevents its display, sponsors will have the option to replace it
- Sponsors can also order mini-banners for \$30 that can be displayed in a home. These banners are one-sided and 14 inches long by 6 inches wide.

How to Order:

- Fill out pages 2 & 3 of this order form and drop it off with payment at THE TOWN OF PARRY SOUND OFFICE, during regular business hours, between May 14 and June 15, 2018 (pictures can be emailed or dropped off with the order form)

- If you are sponsoring more than one veteran to be honoured with a banner, you must submit a separate order form for EACH VETERAN
- Order forms and payment can be submitted from **May 14 to June 15, 2018** at the TOWN OF PARRY SOUND OFFICE (reception desk) during regular business hours, between 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM, Mon. to Fri.
- **PLEASE NOTE: There are a limited number of banners available, so we will accept them on a first come, first served basis. To have a good chance of getting a banner, get your order form and payment in as soon as possible after May 14th. ALSO NOTE: NO ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE MAY 14TH.**
- A photo of your veteran can be submitted with this form (it will be returned to you) or emailed to: richard.lund@nearnorthschools.ca
- **We would much prefer to have pictures scanned and emailed.** If you do this, please be sure the photo is scanned in the highest resolution setting possible. Your printer software lets you adjust this (dpi – dots per inch – the higher the number the better). Photocopies of pictures will not have enough resolution.
