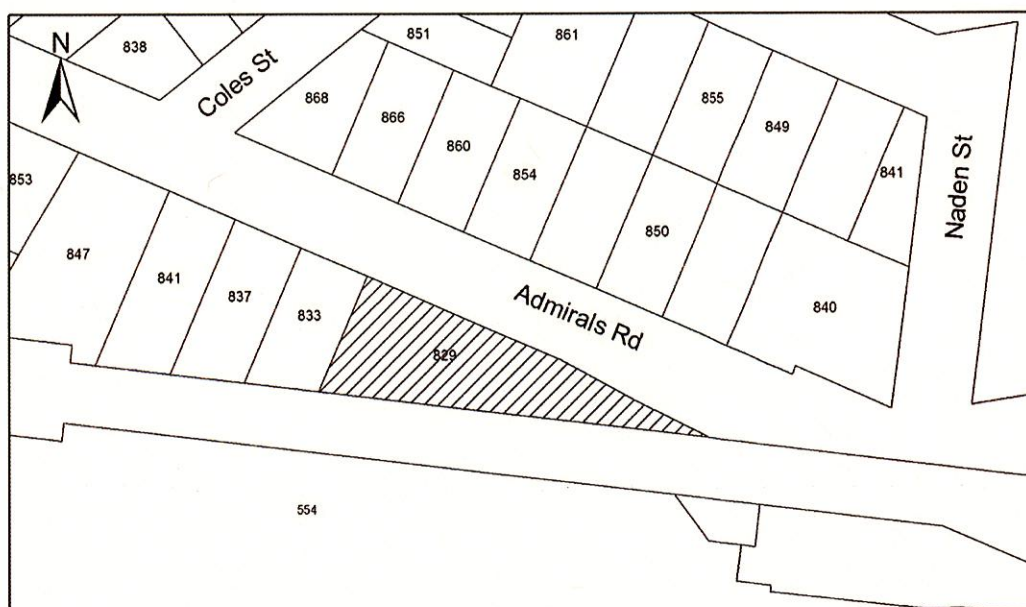
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

An application for a change in zoning has been received for 829 Admirals Road.

Purpose of the Application:

Zoning Bylaw, 1992, No. 2050, Amendment Bylaw No. 2973 provides for a change in the zoning designation of 829 Admirals Road (legal description below), shown hatched on the map below from C-2 (Neighbourhood Commercial) to CD No. 124 (Comprehensive Development District No. 124).

The general purpose of this change in zoning is to add 'Cannabis Sales Store', as a permitted use within 83 m2 on the first storey of the existing building.
