# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

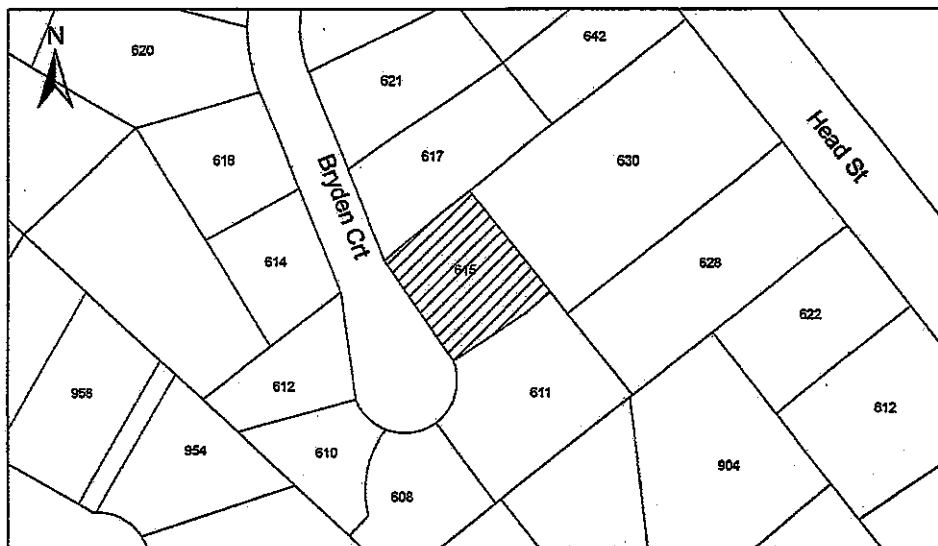
An application for a change in zoning has been received from the registered owners of 615 Bryden Court.
