

## CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

### BYLAW NO. 2983

A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No. 2898, cited as the  
"Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2017, No. 2898"

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2017, No. 2898, Amendment Bylaw [No. 2], 2019, No. 2983"
2. That Bylaw No. 2898, cited as the "Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2017, No. 2898" be amended as follows:

- (1) That the following definition be deleted from: Part 1 – Interpretation, Definitions 2.  
(2) "extraordinary traffic" in its entirety:

*"extraordinary traffic"* includes the carriage of goods in vehicles over a road that, in conjunction with the nature or existing condition of the road, is so extraordinary in the quality and quantity of the goods carried that it substantially increases the burden imposed on the road through its proper use by ordinary traffic, and causes damages to the road or resulting in expense to the municipality beyond what is reasonable or ordinary, and includes six vehicles or more with a total Gross Vehicle Weight in excess of 10,000 kg over a 24 hour period and that originates or ends at a parcel or contiguous parcels of land under the jurisdiction, control or ownership of a person;

- (2) That the following Clause 16 be deleted from Division 2 – Prohibitions: Prohibition of Extraordinary Traffic in its entirety:

16. Extraordinary traffic is prohibited on all streets within the Township unless:

- (a) An Agreement has been entered with a person who is subject to the Bylaw that provides for the payment of compensation to the municipality for the damage to the highway or the resulting expense to the Municipality that may be caused by the extraordinary traffic, and
- (b) The Agreement has been approved by a resolution of Council.

And Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2017, No. 2898 be renumbered accordingly.
