1) <u>21-383</u> Victoria Police Department 2022 Draft Budget

Doug Crowder, Esquimalt Representative, Victoria and Esquimalt Police Board, requested Council provide direction on priorities for consideration as part of the police budget deliberations by responding to the follow questions:

- 1. Which strategic priorities would you highlight in relation to public safety?
- 2. What specific public safety priorities would Council like the Victoria Police Department to focus on?
- 3. What public safety activities would councils consider of lesser priority for the Victoria Police Department?

Council comments included focusing on traffic safety concerns raised by residents, community policing, and youth engagement, as well as fair funding levels for services provided to the community.

Chief Manak and Steve Hurcombe, Controller, responded to questions from Council.
